

Doggy House Rules for Coastguards

Guidelines for Bringing Your Furry Friend:

We welcome guests who wish to bring their canine companions along for a wonderful holiday experience.

To ensure the comfort and safety of all our guests, we kindly ask that you inform us in advance about your dog's type and breed.

- Approval Required: Not all dog breeds are permitted to stay, so it's essential to pre-approve your pet.
- Size and Breed Considerations:
 We may not be able to accommodate larger dogs or those with thick, longhaired coats.
- Advance Notice: Please provide information about your dog at the time of booking or as early as possible. Cont...

The Rules:

- Dogs must be over the age of 1 year at the time of your stay.
- No more than 2 dogs are permitted.
- You may not leave the dog unattended inside or outside Coastguards.
- Your pet must not cause any kind of nuisance to the neighbouring properties.
- Dogs are not permitted in the bedrooms or on any of the furniture in the Coastguards
- Dogs must be clean and dry before entering Coastguards.
- You must clear up any fouling by your dog immediately and dispose of the bag/s in the general waste bin.

We reserve the right to fine up to £150.00 for any non-compliance of the rules above.

Strict adherence to these rules will allow me to continue to welcome dogs to Coastguards.
